Dear Parents and Guardians,

As we move into the month of May, I wish to make an announcement regarding three individuals who play important roles in the life of Salesian High School.

- 1) **Fr. Bill Ferruzzi SDB** has been appointed Director of the Salesian Community here in New Rochelle. In this role, Fr. Bill will be directly responsible for the Salesians who live at 148 Main St. This includes those of us who serve at Salesian High School, the Salesians who minister at Salesian Missions, and the members of the Province staff who live and work in the residence on the hill. In addition, Fr. Bill will oversee the general Salesian mission of the various ministries on campus. As a result, Fr. Bill will not be involved in the day-to-day life of the school although he will still be present on campus. Fr. Bill has been part of Salesian High School for 16 years, and we are grateful for his service, his good humor and his presence.

- 2) **Fr. Richard Rosin SDB** was assigned here as Principal in June. During his brief tenure, he built friendships with many students and began streamlining many administrative processes. Fr. Rich will receive a new assignment later in the month. I am grateful for his time with us and wish him well in his new ministry.

- 3) **Mr. Devin Chisolm** has been appointed Principal of Salesian High School by Fr. Timothy Zak SDB, Provincial. This appointment is effective on July 1, 2018. Mr. Chisolm is an alumnus (Class of 1998). He studied at the University of Miami and American InterContinental University. He has taught Biology and AP Biology since 2007. He was part of the baseball coaching staff; more recently he served on the Strategic Planning Committee and the Middle States Accreditation Central Committee. When Mr. Molinaro retired, Mr. Chisolm was appointed Dean of Students in August 2017. Known for a serious approach to academics, he is also most concerned about the academic, personal and spiritual progress of the students. His love for Salesian High School and its young men is the driving force behind his thoughts and actions. He has shown himself to be a thoughtful educator who believes in seeing results from the plans and actions that we devise. We are most fortunate that he will be our Principal. I look forward to working with him. Accompanying this letter is the letter from Fr. Tim Zak announcing the appointment.
